

Collaborative Artefact 2. The Bunting



Wool is a precious and expensive commodity. The S4S Cornwall participants, (mostly) beginner knitters, learned how to knit, using wool unravelled from spoiled and discarded jumpers. This demonstrated to them the economic and ecological advantages of unravelling wool. The bunting is mounted on a crochet chain, produced in an introductory workshop to crochet. The knitted bunting triangles were decorated with leather and floral embellishments created during leather workshops by the S4S West Midlands participants with the addition of S4S rosettes created for the S4S West Midlands finale event.
